His ideas have inspired psychotherapists for many years. **Jaakko Seikkula** (Finland), PhD, professor in psychotherapy, is known as the generator and researcher of Open Dialogue Approach to therapeutic processes. STRUCTURE OF THE SEMINAR:

During the first day we concentrate to listening to Peter's, John's and Jaakko's presentations. The second and the third days will include practising and discussing in addition to presentations. The seminar has room for 300 participants, who possibly will be assigned to three sub groups at times. The presentations and the comments from the speakers (excluding the mutual reflections and conversations of the presenters) will be translated in Finnish.
